**Appointment of New Circuit Executive and Clerk of the Court for the
Federal Circuit**

The court is pleased to announce the selection of Jarrett B. Perlow as the next Circuit Executive and Clerk of Court for the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit. Mr. Perlow will be succeeding Peter R. Marksteiner as Circuit Executive and Clerk of Court, who is retiring as of June 30, 2023.

Mr. Perlow has served as Chief Deputy Clerk of the Federal Circuit since December 2016 and has held various legal and managerial positions within the federal judiciary over the past two decades.

During his tenure with the Federal Circuit, Mr. Perlow has received numerous recognitions for his work in enhancing court operations. In 2018, he was co-recipient of the federal judiciary's Director's Award for Excellence in Court Operations based on his efforts to improve mission-essential functions in the Clerk's Office during his first 18 months with the court. Under his leadership, the Clerk's Office subsequently received the national 2019 W. Edwards Deming Outstanding Training Award in Human Capital Management for process enhancements to the court's training program. Finally, his five-year effort to integrate quality management practices into the Clerk's Office led to the office's silver-level validation in March 2022 by the American Society for Quality's Government Division under the national ASQ/ANSI G1:2021 Guidelines for Evaluating the Quality of Government Operations and Services. Upon achieving this distinction, the Clerk's Office became the first organization in the federal government to receive this recognition.

In addition to his work at the court, Mr. Perlow is currently serving as a Resident Fellow in the Director's Leadership Program at the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, where he is leading the development and initiation of a nationwide court process improvement program across the federal judiciary. He is also a Certified Court Executive through the National Center for State Courts, and this summer he will complete an Institute for Court Management fellowship with the National Center for State Courts based on his research into federal court quality management best practices.

Mr. Perlow will officially assume the responsibilities of Circuit Executive and Clerk of Court on July 1, 2023.
