## Federal Circuit Schedules October Session for the Dallas-Fort Worth Area

The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit is pleased to announce that it intends to sit in Dallas and Fort Worth, Texas as part of its October 2019 session. The Federal Circuit will also hold its regular session in Washington, D.C.

Panels of the court will hear arguments at the following Dallas-Fort Worth area law schools and the federal courthouse:

The cases scheduled for the October 2019 session will be posted on the <u>court's</u> <u>website</u> once finalized.

The Federal Circuit regularly hears arguments outside of Washington, D.C. as part of its nationwide jurisdiction and statutory requirement to provide "reasonable opportunities to citizens to appear before the court." Most recently, the Federal Circuit has held sessions in Chicago, Illinois; New York City, New York; Los Angeles, California; Boston, Massachusetts; Baltimore, Maryland; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, Wilmington, Delaware; and Minneapolis, Minnesota.
